

# GRAVELIST OF JEWISH SECTION OF HOPPENLAU CEMETERY IN STUTTGART

This gravelist was originally compiled in 1987 in German language by Joachim Hahn in cooperation with Rolf Decrauzat, Richard Klotz and Hermann Ziegler, containing various grave inscriptions which in 1952 still existed but by 1987 had developed illegible - besides that quite a few grave stones had "disappeared" between 1952 and 1987 for whatever unknown reasons.

In 1988 this gravelist was published as printed version by Stuttgart City Archive under director Dr Paul Sauer.

Jewish Hoppenlau Cemetery is the oldest existing Jewish Cemetery of Stuttgart and served as a burial site from 1834 until 1873 (plus some exceptional burials even later), interments thereafter generally took place at the Jewish section of Prag Cemetery in Stuttgart (founded in 1873). Before 1834 Jewish families of Stuttgart had their burial sites at the Jewish cemeteries of nearby Freudental and Hochberg. The printed 1988 version of Jewish Hoppenlau Cemetery contains more details on the history of Jewish families in Stuttgart and their burial grounds.

English translation plus additional family research details for an updated version of 2013 was compiled and digitalized by Rolf Hofmann (harburgproject@aol.com) in preparation of an internet version, hoping for feedback of living descendants of the deceased mentioned in this gravelist. Errors regarding vital records are inevitable, due to enormous difficulties in gathering family history details from a huge amount of historic sources, often enough contradictory. Corrections and additional information will be gratefully accepted.

Details from original family sheets were provided by Dr Roland Mueller (director of Stuttgart City Archive).

All entries are noted in alphabetic order of family names.

**ABENHEIM** Isabella (Bela) (nee Auerbacher) 22 Jul 1810 Nordstetten – 14 Jun 1860 Stuttgart  
daughter of Loew Auerbacher + wife Fanny nee Uffenheimer  
since 1835 wife of Joseph Abenheim 21 Nov 1804 Worms – 17 Jan 1891 Stuttgart  
since 1825 as violinist member of Court Orchestra in Stuttgart, since 1854 Royal Court Music Director  
his parents = Heinrich (Herz) Abenheim + wife Theresa (Teichel) nee Gernsheim  
row 7-12 grave 1438

**ABENHEIM** Rosalie 05 Dec 1837 Stuttgart – 29 Nov 1838 Stuttgart (probably got no grave marker)  
daughter of Court Music Director Joseph Abenheim + wife Isabella nee Auerbacher

**ADLER** Doris 29 Aug 1873 Stuttgart – 05 Sep 1873 Stuttgart  
daughter of Jonas Adler + wife Rebecca nee Ulmer  
grave site unknown

Jonas Adler (05 Aug 1833 Schwabach – 07 Jul 1900 Stuttgart) married before 1865 Rebecca Ulmer (31 Jul 1839 Schwabach – 02 Oct 1882 Stuttgart) - couple lived in San Francisco USA around 1865

**ALEXANDER** Therese (nee Neumann) 06 Oct 1815 Lauchheim – 22 Jun 1869 Stuttgart  
daughter of Hirsch Neumann + wife Heffel  
since 1838 second wife of antiques trader Isak Alexander  
row 6-5 grave 1421

Isak Alexander was born on 10 Jul 1811 in Hengstfeld and originally worked as a weaver in Hengstfeld, but then became a qualified trader of valuable antiques. He married Therese as his second wife in 1838. In 1837 he had married his first wife Breindel Kahn (01 Nov 1813 Duensbach – 19 Jan 1838 Hengstfeld) = daughter of Loew Kahn + wife Lea. In 1867 he settled in Stuttgart, in 1885 he moved to Noerdlingen, where his daughter Sara lived and where he died in 1892

**ALTMANN** Joseph 07 Jan 1819 Niederstetten – 31 May 1870 Stuttgart  
businessmann + banker in Stuttgart, since 1846 in New York, later returned to Stuttgart  
son of David Altmann + wife Elka nee Kohn  
since 1846 husband of Caroline (Guetel) Stettheimer 31 Jul 1826 Niederstetten - ? (died where ?)  
parents = Moses Stettheimer + wife Jette Chaja (see graves 1501 + 1533)  
row 18-9 grave 1587

Joseph Altmann's mother Elka was born in Kleinerdingen in 1788 and had first married Mendel Badmann in Oettingen who died before 1813 - Elka thereafter married David Altmann on 07 Jan 1813 in Niederstetten - as a widow she lived with her son Joseph in Stuttgart and died on 03 Jan 1882 (buried at Jewish Prag Cemetery).

**ARNOLD** Abraham Mayer 13 Sep 1808 Jebenhausen – 15 Mar 1871 Stuttgart  
since 1847 textile wholesaler in Stuttgart with partner Elias Gutmann (born in Jebenhausen)  
both partners founded cotton spinning mill in Muehlhausen near Stuttgart  
son of Mayer Abraham Arnold + wife Sara nee Regensburger  
since 1836 husband of Babette (Bonle) Regensburger 06 Apr 1814 Jebenhausen – 14 Sep 1881 (died where ?)  
her parents were Jonathan Aaron Regensburger + wife Fanny (Voegele) nee Loebstein  
row 13-8 grave 1512

**ARNOLD** Ernestine - see Ernestine Gutmann (nee Arnold)  
row 3-15 (grave marker disappeared)

**ARNOLD** Jette - see Jette Marx (nee Arnold)  
row 15-10 grave 1541

**ARNOLD** Jonathan Mayer 12 Apr 1810 Jebenhausen – 03 Mar 1865 Stuttgart  
since 1849 wool trader in Stuttgart  
son of Mayer Abraham Arnold + wife Sara nee Regensburger  
since 1839 husband of Pauline Rescher from Hochberg (grave 1495b)  
row 12-3 grave 1495a

**ARNOLD** Max 22 Sep 1853 Stuttgart – 16 Apr 1871 Stuttgart  
son of Abraham Mayer Arnold + wife Babette (Bonle) nee Regensburger  
row 12-8 grave 1499

**ARNOLD** Pauline (nee Rescher) 12 Aug 1819 Hochberg – 11 May 1878 Stuttgart  
daughter of Salomon Rescher + wife Ruchesh nee Herz  
since 1839 wife of Jonathan Mayer Arnold (grave 1495a)  
row 12-4 grave 1495b

**ARNOLD** Sara (nee Regensburger) 11 Aug 1777 Jebenhausen – 17 Jun 1864 Stuttgart  
moved from Jebenhausen to Stuttgart in 1859

daughter of Aron Loeb Regensburger + wife Juetle nee Kahn  
since 1806 wife of Mayer Abraham Arnold (17 Apr 1782 Eberstatt – 07 Aug 1853 Jebenhausen)  
son of Abraham + wife Schenle in Eberstatt  
Mayer Abraham Arnold was buried in Jebenhausen  
row 13-5 grave 1510

**ARON** Sophie - see Sophie Hirsch (nee Aron)  
row 13-9

**ASCHER** Hedwig 01 Apr 1866 Stuttgart – 07 Jun 1873 Stuttgart  
daughter of cigar trader Sigmund Ascher in Stuttgart  
grave site unknown

**ASCHER** Jeanette (nee Strauss) 1813 Messelhausen (Baden) – 01 Jun 1865 Stuttgart (52 years old)  
daughter of Joseph Strauss + wife Karoline  
since 1837 wife of businessman Aaron Isaac Ascher in Weikersheim (1803 – 1859)  
row 12-5 grave 1496

**AUERBACH** Albert 17 Dec 1831 Cannstatt – 25 Feb 1880 Stuttgart  
son of Julius Auerbacher + wife Amalie nee Dreifuss  
husband of NN (so far unknown) - graveinscription = "for the beloved husband + father"  
row 16-3 grave 1561

**AUERBACHER** Isabella - see Isabella Abenheim (nee Auerbacher)  
row 7-12 grave 1438 ?

**AUERBACHER** Karl 10 Sep 1868 Stuttgart – 22 Feb 1869 Stuttgart  
son of Benjamin Auerbacher + wife Emma nee Froehlich  
grave site unknown

**AUERBACH** Salomon ? died ca 1841/42 as child - no death record available  
row 18-16 grave 1592 (grave inscription was still legible in 1952 but no more in 1987)

**AUERBACHER** Brunette - see Brunette Froehlich (nee Auerbacher)  
row 14-6 grave 1524

**AUERBACH** Emil 02 Oct 1812 Nordstetten – 29 May 1867 Stuttgart (born as Jonas)  
studied medicine in Tuebingen since 1831, practitioner + obstetrician (Dr med) since 1848 in Stuttgart  
son of Loew Auerbacher + wife Fanny nee Uffenheimer  
since 1846 husband of Rosa (Reine) nee Holland 09 Nov 1825 Stuttgart – 03 Jun 1885 Stuttgart  
(buried at Jewish Prag Cemetery)  
daughter of Phillip Holland + wife Caroline nee Baer  
row 9-1 grave 1451

original family sheet shows Reine nee Holland's birth date as 04 Jun 1817

**AUERBACHER** Fanny (nee Hilb) 20 Dec 1814 Haigerloch – 23 Dec 1873 Stuttgart  
daughter of Veit Hilb + wife Michelina nee Ullmann  
since 1836 wife of horse dealer Wolf Emanuel Auerbacher 28 May 1811 Nordstetten - 06 Nov 1892 Stuttgart  
son of Emanuel Auerbacher + wife Mariam nee Kiefe  
couple lived in Nordstetten, since 1873 in Stuttgart  
row 5-20 grave 1416

**AUERBACHER** Fanny (nee Uffenheimer) ca 1773 - 07 Feb 1844 Stuttgart  
daughter of Josua Uffenheimer + wife Babette (Breinle)  
since 1797 wife of Loew Auerbacher (her first husband) 1772 Nordstetten – 01 Jun 1816 Nordstetten  
son of Maier Auerbacher + wife Rosette nee Weil  
since 1821 wife of Jakob Lazarus (her second husband) 18 Jul 1798 Esslingen – 26 Aug 1833 Nordstetten  
son of Isaak Lazarus + wife Sara nee Ochs  
row 17-15 grave 1577

Fanny Auerbacher was the mother of Dr med Emil Auerbach (!), Julius Auerbacher and Rebekka Maier

**AUERBACHER** Julius 02 Feb 1805 Nordstetten – 21 Dec 1854 Stuttgart  
wine trader in Cannstatt, later in Stuttgart  
son of Loew Auerbacher + wife Fanny nee Uffenheimer  
since 1829 husband of Rachel Seligmann 19 Mar 1808 Stuttgart– 11 Oct 1887 Stuttgart  
(buried at Jewish Prag Cemetery)  
daughter of Amschel Seligmann + wife Fanny nee Ullmann  
row 16-1 grave 1560

**AUERBACHER** Mariam (nee Kiefe) ca 1782 Baisingen – 19 Dec 1851 Stuttgart  
daughter of Maier Kiefe + wife Regina (Res) nee Kiefe  
since 1801 wife of Mendel (Emanuel) Auerbacher 1768 Nordstetten – 14 Apr 1843 Nordstetten  
son of Baruch Auerbacher + wife Res

**BACH** Mathilde 12 May 1864 Stuttgart – 02 Apr 1870 Stuttgart (killed by a mail coach running over her)  
daughter of Samson Bach + wife Rosalie nee Auerbacher

**BACHER** Esther (nee Jordan) 1793 Freudental – 28 Mar 1857 Stuttgart  
daughter of Judas Jordan + wife Rosalie nee Joseph  
since 1819 wife of Court Jew Abraham Bacher ca 1792 Hechingen – 04 Dec 1840 Hechingen  
son of Moses Abraham Bacher (Court Jew in Hechingen since 1804) + wife Lea  
row 11-13 grave 1488 (white marble inscription plate missing)

**BARUCH** Bernhard 25 Jan 1813 Bernstadt/Silesia – 16 Sep 1871 Stuttgart  
garment dealer in Stuttgart  
husband of Helene nee NN (died after 1871)  
row 8-10 (gravestone missing)

### **BENEDICT FAMILY**

Respected Jewish family in Stuttgart since 1770 when Baruch Benedict (born 1734 in Kriegshaber as son of Wolf Seligmann + wife Delzel) was allowed to settle in Stuttgart together with his wife Roesle nee Federmann. Baruch Benedict served as shochet for the Court Jews living in Stuttgart. The couple produced four children = Seligmann Loeb + Moses + Sara + Isaac. Around 1800 brothers Seligmann + Moses founded bank business "Gebrueder Benedict", which in 1869 became part of "Wuerttembergische Vereinsbank". Both brothers were also cofounders of "Museums-Gesellschaft" in 1807, an important cultural initiative in Stuttgart. Baruch + Roesle Benedict were buried in Freudenthal, and so was Seligmann Loew Benedict.

**BENEDICT** Luise (nee Lebret) 23 Nov 1816 Stuttgart – 04 Mar 1872 Stuttgart  
daughter of Christian Immanuel Lebret + wife Eleonore Christine nee Waechter

since 1837 wife of Sigmund Benedict 07 Mar 1809 Stuttgart – 14 Nov 1852 Strasbourg, Alsace, France  
son of Moses Benedict + wife Flora von Geldern  
Sigmund Benedict converted to Lutheran religion in 1836  
row 17-5 (gravestone missing)

**BENEDICT** Max 07 Mar 1829 – 06 Mar 1864 Stuttgart  
lawyer in Stuttgart  
unmarried son of Adolf Benedict + wife Jeanette nee Kaulla  
row 20-9/10 grave 1612

**BENEDICT** Moses 17 Feb 1772 Stuttgart – 08 Jul 1852 Stuttgart  
since 1785 student at "Hohe Karlsschule" in Stuttgart, elite college founded by Duke Carl Eugen  
banker + sculpturer + painter in Stuttgart  
son of Baruch Benedict + wife Roesle nee Federmann  
since 1800 husband of Flora (Bluemchen) von Geldern 02 Oct 1777 Duesseldorf – 30 Jun 1828 Stuttgart  
(Flora was buried in Freudental)  
daughter of Brunella ? von Geldern  
row 17-1-grave 1570 (inscription illegible)

**BENEDICT** Therese - see Therese Goudcheaux nee Benedict  
row 9-11 grave 1458

**BERLINGER** Bernhard 17 Jun 1868 Stuttgart – 25 Aug 1868 Stuttgart  
son of Jakob Berlinger (from Hochberg) + wife Mathilde nee Neuburger (from Stuttgart)  
(gravesite unknown)

**BERNHEIM** Hugo 29 Jan 1865 Stuttgart – 31 Aug 1869 Stuttgart  
son of Moritz Bernheim + wife Amalie nee Burgmann - killed by falling from rooftop - he was deaf and dumb  
row 5-9 gravesite unknown (inscription plate still existed in 1952)

**BERNHEIM** Max 12 Oct 1863 Stuttgart – 21 Mar 1865 Stuttgart  
son of Moritz Bernheim + wife Amalie nee Burgmann  
row 1-20 in 1952, row 5-6 in 1987 grave 1409

**BERNHEIM** Sara - see Sara Liebmann nee Bernheim  
row 13-6 grave 1500

**BING** Eva - see Eva Kaulla nee Bing  
row 20-3 grave 1610

**BLOCH** Bertha Aug 1860 – 06 Jan 1873  
daughter of merchant Bloch from Berlin  
row 12-18 grave 1506

**BLUM** Henriette - see Henriette Thalheimer nee Blum  
row 15-18 grave 1549

**BLUMENFELD** Albert 08 Sep 1836 Stuttgart – 25 Nov 1862 Stuttgart (suicide)  
unmarried banker in Stuttgart  
only son of banker Nathan Raphael Blumenfeld + wife Lisette nee Levi  
row 5-15 grave 1412 b

**BLUMENFELD** Nathan Raphael 10 Jun 1799 Creglingen – 03 Dec 1862 (suicide)  
banker in Stuttgart, since 1837 cashier for Wilhelmspflege in Esslingen  
son of Raphael Lazarus Blumenfeld in Creglingen + wife Jette (Juedle) Ostheimer (from Welbhausen)  
since 1831 husband of Lisette Levi 17 Oct 1807 Hechingen – 18 Feb 1887 Stuttgart  
daughter of David Levi + wife Therese (Dorchen) nee Liebermann  
row 5-14 grave 1412 a

**BOSCAWITZ** Ella (Eleonore) (geb Seligmann) 08 Mar 1804 Stuttgart – 11 Sep 1869 Stuttgart

daughter of Court Jew Amschel Seligmann + wife Fanny nee Ullmann  
since 1829 wife of Joseph Boscawitz 15 Jun 1790 Floss (Upper Palatinate) – May 1872 Stuttgart (buried where ?)  
book keeper for Kaulla family + merchant in Esslingen since 1829, moved to Stuttgart in 1831  
son of Amschel Boscawitz + wife Jeanette (Jette) nee Rothschild  
couple lived in Stuttgart since 1829  
row 19-10 grave 1601

**CHAILLY** Jakob 01 Oct 1770 Nancy, France – 24 May 1848 Stuttgart  
by 1811 Court Jew in Stuttgart (produced gold embroidery)  
son of Court Jew + hazzan Maier Chailly + wife Mahlchen nee Lehmann  
married (1) Sara Heimann Dec 1767 Emmendingen (Baden) – June 1804  
= daughter of NN Wellenhauser  
widow of iron dealer Samuel Ahron in Pforzheim who died 15 Jun 1799  
married (2) 01 Jun 1807 Johanna Maier 1761 Kuppenheim (Baden) – 06 Mar 1822  
daughter of NN Maier  
married (3) 04 Sep 1826 Marie Schneider 18 Aug 1795 Mannheim – 04 Dec 1868 Stuttgart  
daughter of Gumpert Schneider + wife Fanny nee Homburger

daughter Charlotte Chailly (29 Sep 1836 – 07 Nov 1899) married in 1856 Albert Gueldenstein -

**COHEN** Alfred 18 Jul 1842 Stuttgart – 28 Apr 1857 Stuttgart  
son of landowner August Cohen + wife Rebekka nee Kaulla  
row 11-14 grave 1489

**COHEN** August 15 or 30 Dec 1812 Hannover – 14 Dec 1869 Stuttgart  
landowner at Schafland estate  
son of Jacob Leffman Cohen + wife Lea Herz Salomon  
since 1839 husband of Rebekka nee Kaulla (grave 1508)  
row 18-8 grave 1586 (inscription illegible)

**COHEN** Emilie 14 Apr 1848 Stuttgart – 02 Feb 1863 Stuttgart

row 7-14 gravesite between 1439 and 1439 (no gravestone available)

**DESSAUER** Simon 07 Mar 1803 Unterschwandorf – 17 May 1867 Stuttgart  
engraver in Pflaumloch, since 1863 in Stuttgart  
son of Gottlieb Dessauer + wife Clara nee Schweizer  
since 1831 husband of Fanni Stein 19 Jul 1811 Pflaumloch – 23 Nov 1874 Stuttgart (buried at Prag Cemetery)  
daughter of Rabbi Substitute Elias Moses Stein + wife Jette

row 10-7 grave 1471 (grave inscription illegible)

**DIESENHOFER** David ? – 31 Jan 1874  
he was from Wilhermsdorf and probably died on a business trip

practitioner (Dr med), later banker, chief manager of "Gebrueder Benedict Bank" in Stuttgart  
son of Court Jew Gabriel Dreifus + wife Pauline nee Rescher in Hochberg (since 1807 in Stuttgart)  
since 1829 husband of Henriette nee Benedict (grave 1751 b)  
row 17-2 grave 1571 a

**EDERHEIMER** Lina 06 Mar 1849 Esslingen – 24 Aug 1865 Stuttgart  
daughter of Jakob Ederheimer + wife Ernestine (Esther) nee Levi  
row 12-7 grave 1498 (top of headstone + inscription missing)

**EICHBERG** Theodor Samuel 19 Mar 1843 - ? (must have died ca 1867 – 1875 ?)  
son of ?  
family sheet of hazzan Moritz Eichberg + wife Eleanor nee Seligsberg doesn't mention a son Theodor Samuel

## **KAULLA FAMILY**

One of the most important family of bankers and Court Jews during the 1800s and 1900s in Southern Germany. They were descendants of Raphael Isak and his wife Rebekka in Buchau, later Hechingen. Around 1800 Madame Kaulla was Germany's most significant Court Jewess. She started her career in Donaueschingen and Hechingen, serving the Hohenzollern Princes and since 1770 established her activities in Stuttgart for Duke Carl Eugen of Wuerttemberg. In 1800 Madame Kaulla's brother Jacob Kaulla became Court Banker in Stuttgart and in 1802 founded "Wuerttembergische Hofbank" (Court Bank of Wuerttemberg), long time most important bank business in the Kingdom of Wuerttemberg

A passport application at [www.ancestry.com](http://www.ancestry.com) shows that Julius Oberndorf had emigrated to the USA in 1849 and was naturalized as American citizen in 1865. Around 1863 he married Emilie Eichberg, born 25 Nov 1840 in Stuttgart as daughter of hazzan Moritz Eichberg + wife Eleanor Seligsberg. She had emigrated to New York in 1862. Despite the fact that the couple lived in New York, they must have spent much of their time in Europe. They had altogether three children born in Stuttgart = Wilhelm David (born 30 Aug 1867) + Paula (born in 1871) + Edwin (born 26 Mar 1873). Julius Oberndorf died on 21 Oct 1896 in New York – his wife Emilie died in 1892 in Nice, France.
