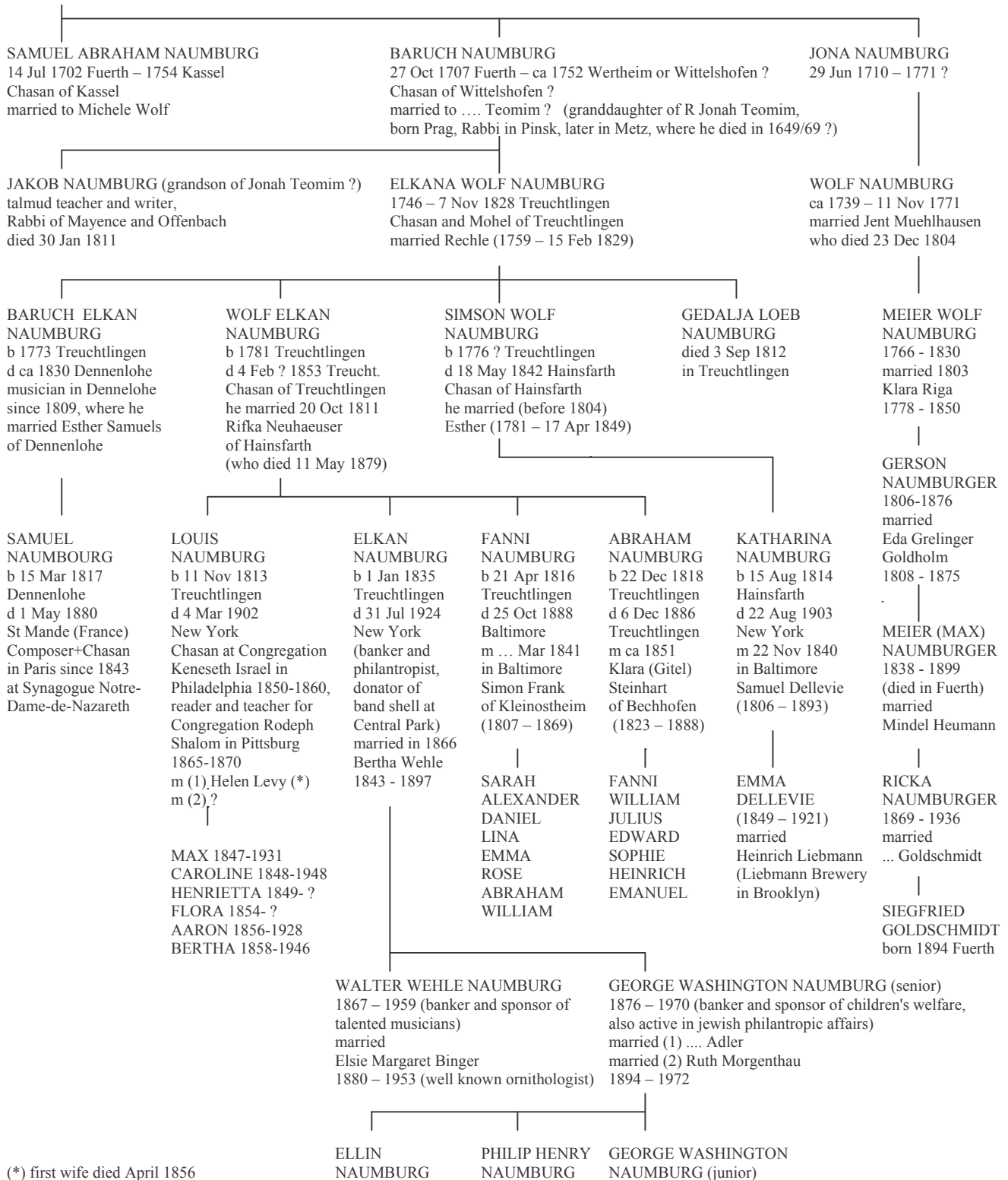
Extract of ancestral chart compiled by Rolf Hofmann by using results of fellow researchers. The surname "Naumburg" may derive from the village "Naumburg an der Saale" or even from the tiny village "Naumburg am Bober" (?) close to Glogau in Silesia, which before 1742 was austrian, then prussian, since 1871 part of the German Empire and now belongs to Poland. "Glogau" became "Glogow" and "Naumburg am Bober" became "Nowgorod Bobranski" in polish language.

ABRAHAM NAUMBURG was Chasan in Prag around 1612

BARUCH NAUMBURG was Abraham Naumburg's son

BENJAMIN WOLF NAUMBURG (son of Baruch Naumburg) was Chasan in Gross Glogau (married to a daughter of Rabbi Jonah Teomim of Pinsk ?)

ELKANA NAUMBURG (born Gross Glogau in Silesia around 1662/82 ?, died 1 Jul 1746 Fuerth) Chasan in Fuerth, he was married to Rebekka Sara ?, who died 15 Dec 1722 (maybe there was another wife = Guetel Maas ??)
