BERNHARD BRADER (A)

born 30 ? Nov 1818 Sugenheim, died 25 Apr 1898 Noerdlingen
(1847-49 he was a teacher in Hagenbach, Franconia, in 1849 he moved to Moenchsdeggingen near Harburg in Swabia and served there as a teacher until the end of the Jewish community. After 1870 he moved to Noerdlingen, where in 1879 he bought house Birkgasse A 204 and in 1890 finally became a citizen of the town)

(parents = Isaak Wolf Brader + wife Roesele nee Hammelbacher) (B)

married (1) 8 Aug 1850 in Nuernberg (first Jewish marriage in Nuernberg after 350 years !)

CAROLINE GUTMANN

born 15 May 1824 Sugenheim, died 12 Jun 1865 Moenchsdeggingen
(father = Kallmann Loew Gutmann + wife Malka)

married (2) 20 Feb 1867 in Moenchsdeggingen

BABETTE HAMMELBACHER

born 22 Jul 1840 Sugenheim, died ?
(parents = Isak Hammelbacher + wife Esther nee Brader)

CHILDREN FIRST MARRIAGE (all born in Moenchsdeggingen):

- (01) ISAK 14 Nov 1851 - 10 Mar 1920 (died in Ichenhausen)
he became a teacher in Ichenhausen
he married (1) 22 Oct 1873 in Harburg
Karoline Weinbach (25 Mar 1850 - 6 Oct 1899),
he married (2) 18 Feb 1902 in Karlsruhe
Esther Floersheimer (18 Feb 1902 - ?) -
Isak's son Benny Brader (1 Oct 1874 - 2 Dec 1942),
since 1809 in Munich, died in Theresienstadt
- (02) SAMUEL 20 Dec 1852 - 25 Jul 1895 (died in Munich)
he became a baker in Munich and married 1878 (?)
(C) Pauline Levisohn of Lauchheim
(11 Sep 1854 - 3 Sep 1942, died in Theresienstadt)
see own family sheet
- (03) SIMON 05 Feb 1854 - 31 Jul 1936 (died in Munich)
he first was an apprentice since 1868 with Samuel
Kronheimer in Fuerth and still worked for him
(D) in 1873 - he married 16 Aug 1886 Bertha Levisohn
of Lauchheim (12 Sep 1859 - 19 Oct 1926)
couple moved from Fuerth to Munich in 1906
(see own family sheet)
- (04) MORITZ 18 Feb 1855 - ?
probably emigrated to the USA in 1880
as a tailor (and joined his brother Henry ?) ?

- (05) HEINRICH 11 Jul 1856 - 01 Jul 1901 (?)
(called Henry) probably emigrated to the USA in 1874
after he had gambled and lost everything
- (06) NN (stillborn girl) 27 May 1858 - 27 May 1858
- (07) PAULINE 04 Jul 1861 - ? died after 1939 (when ?)
she married Max Schiff,
teacher in Hoffenheim in Baden
- CHILDREN SECOND MARRIAGE (08-12 born Moenchsdeggingen, 13-14 Noerdlingen ?)
- (08) KAROLINE 08 May 1868 - ca 15 Aug 1893
married Moritz Heumann in Hoffenheim/Baden
- (09) VICTOR 03 May 1869 - ?
married 21 or 30 Aug 1896 in Augsburg
Anna Erb, born 27 Oct 1862 in Ravensburg
(her parents = David Erb + Elisabeth nee Moser)
couple had one child before their marriage =
Franz David, born 23 Mar 1888 in Augsburg
(Victor + Anna lived in Augsburg)
- (10) BETTINA 25 Nov 1871 - died ca 1942 (murdered in Riga)
she married 11 Apr 1899 in Noerdlingen
Jakob Ansel, born 8 Apr 1873 in Koblenz
(also murdered ca 1942 in Riga)
- (11) ELONORA 27 May 1873 - 29 Jun 1873
- (12) ROSALIE 07 Aug 1875 - 11 Aug 1875
- (13) LUDWIG 18 Oct 1876 - ? (died as victim of the shoah)
married 17 Oct 1904 in Wuerzburg
Fanny Hoffmann, born 14 Feb 1878 in Laudenbach
(her parents = Samson Hoffmann + Hanna nee Selz)
Ludwig + Fanny were deported from Frankfurt/Main
and died in Eastern Europe as victims of the shoah
- (14) AMALIE 20 Feb 1880 - ? was still single in 1898,
lived in Magdeburg, Kaiser Strasse 110 I
(in 1903)

(A) Leo Baeck Document Archive in Tel Aviv has a biography on him (nr 223) -
Bernhard Brader's sister Esther Brader (10 Oct 1816 - 10 May 1897)
married 26 Aug 1839 in Sugenheim Isaac Hammelbacher (20 Jun 1795 - 1863)

(B) Isaak Wolf Brader was born in 1771, married in Sugenheim ca 1809. He was
a peddler dealing mainly with drapery. He bought house nr 109 (today Schloss
Strasse 29). His children = Guetel (Karoline) born 1813 married Salomon
Weissmann, Esther born 10 Oct 1816 married Isaak Hammelbacher on 26 Aug 1839,
Bernhard Brader (see above). This information comes from Thea Ruth Skyte.

(C) Pauline was born as "Bertha (Breindel)" 11 Sep 1854 in Lauchheim between
Aalen and Noerdlingen (and had strangely enough the same first name as her
sister Bertha born in 1859). She was the daughter of baker Jakob Levisohn
(15 Nov 1817 Lauchheim - 15 Feb 1899 Munich) and his wife Reiz (Regina) nee
Hirschinger (17 Mar 1821 Gunzenhausen - ?), Pauline's parents moved to Munich

around 1884 (?)

Pauline's brother Moritz Levisohn (probably born as "Moses" 12 Aug 1853 in Lauchheim) was a banker in Munich around 1898.

(D) Bertha Levisohn was the sister of Pauline and Moritz, she was born 22 Aug 1859 in Lauchheim and had (according to the family sheet of her parents) the same first name as her sister Bertha (Breindel) born in 1854 !
