(B) **Else Schuelein** from Frankfurt/Main

04 Apr 1875 - 25 Dec 1961

(died in Forest Hills, New York USA)

couple had two sons (born in Frankfurt/Main):

(a) **Josef Gunzenhaeuser**

06 Jul 1896 - 01 Jul 1942 (Theresienstadt)

he was a lawyer (Dr jur) in company with

Benno Schuelein at Perusa Strasse 2 in Munich

(b) **Adolph Gunzenhaeuser**

13 Aug 1897 - January 1974

(died in Flushing, Queens, New York USA)

married

08 Oct 1894 - April 1993 (died in Flushing)

(Adolph's wife is an assumption from SSDI)

(A) David Jacob Gunzenhaeuser donated a torah shield to the Feuchtwangen Synagogue, which was saved during the 1930s by Dr Hermann Schuelein and taken to Beth Hillel Synagogue in New York.

(B) Else Gunzenhaeuser was deported to Theresienstadt on 3 Jun 1942, but was released on 5 Feb 1945 and managed to emigrate to the USA via Switzerland
